Northeastern North Carolina Partnership for Public Health (NENCPPH) Regional HIV Care, Prevention, and Testing Program



HIV Specialty Care and Treatment Services

The HIV program has 5 regional mobile clinic sites to provide **HIV Specialty Care and Treatment** services in northeastern North Carolina. Clients are generally seen once every three months.

- **Medical** services are provided by the **Infectious Disease Division** at Brody School of Medicine, East Carolina University.
- Health in Motion is **managed** by **NENCPPH staff** under the direction of the **Infectious Disease Clinic** at **Hertford County Public Health Authority**.
- **Clients** eligible to receive services include individuals with a documented **positive HIV** test result.
- The program receives **funding** from a **Ryan White Part B** grant and a **Kate B. Reynolds** grant.

HIV Prevention and Nontraditional HIV/STD Community Health Outreach Activities

The program also visits communities to provide HIV prevention and health outreach activities. Screenings for cholesterol, diabetes, hypertension, and infectious diseases are offered at these events.
