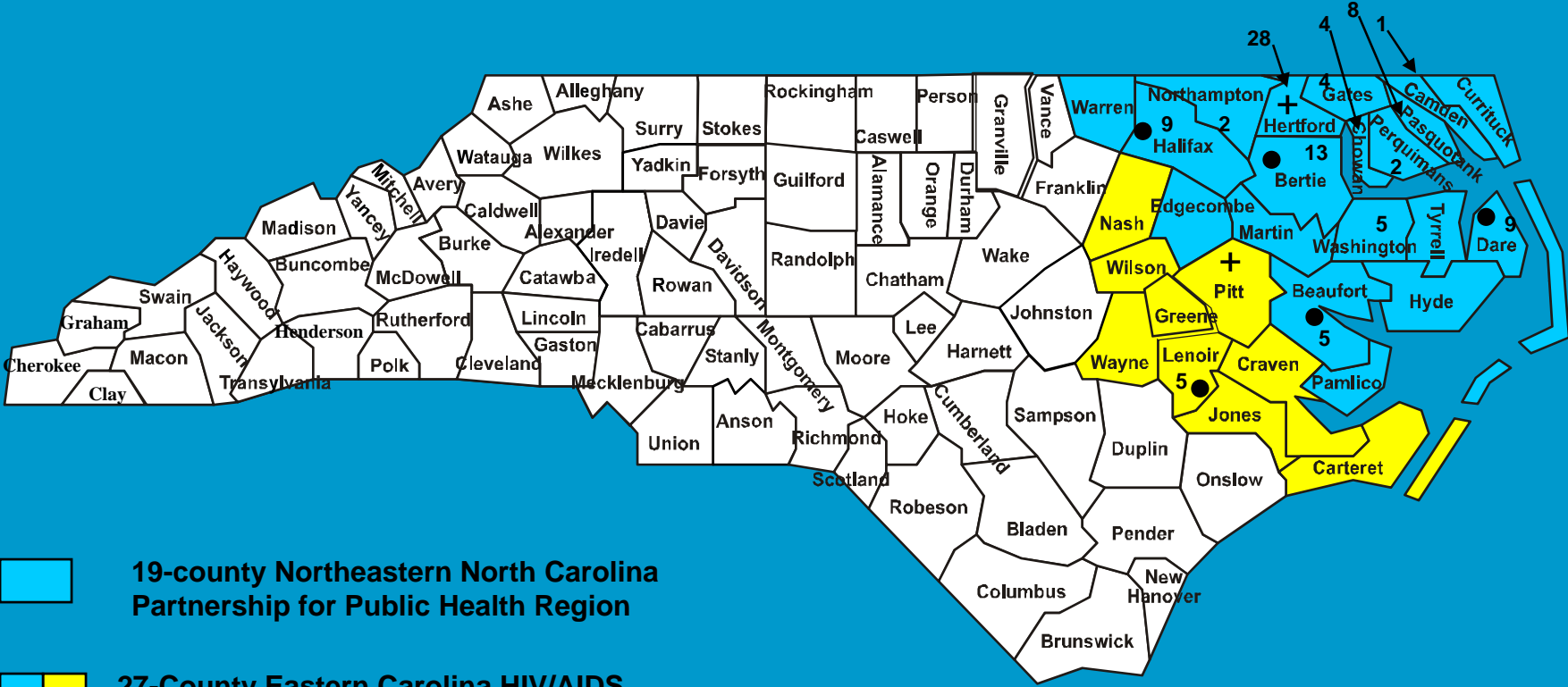

HIV Specialty Care: Clients

Clients entering care 12/03-Present

- ~6 clients newly diagnosed, new to care
- ~1 client previously diagnosed, new to care
- ~18 clients fallen out of care, returned to care
- ~70 clients referred to care for access

HIV Specialty Care: Clients

Medical Status

- Acute/CD4<200-23 clients
- Stable/CD4>200-69 clients

Psycho-social Status

- Mental Health, Substance Abuse, Transport, and/or other risk-20 clients
 - 7 clients medically acute
 - 13 clients medically stable

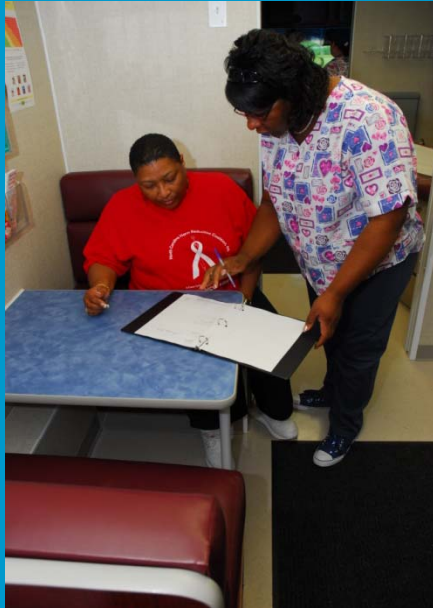
HIV Specialty Care: Clients

Client's progress in clinic

Of 41 currently active clients that enrolled in clinic between 1/04-12/06

- 13 enrolled at acute stage
 - 11 of the 13 show improved CD4 counts
 - 8 of the 13 are now considered stable
 - 1 of the 28 enrolled with a stable CD4 count, is now acute

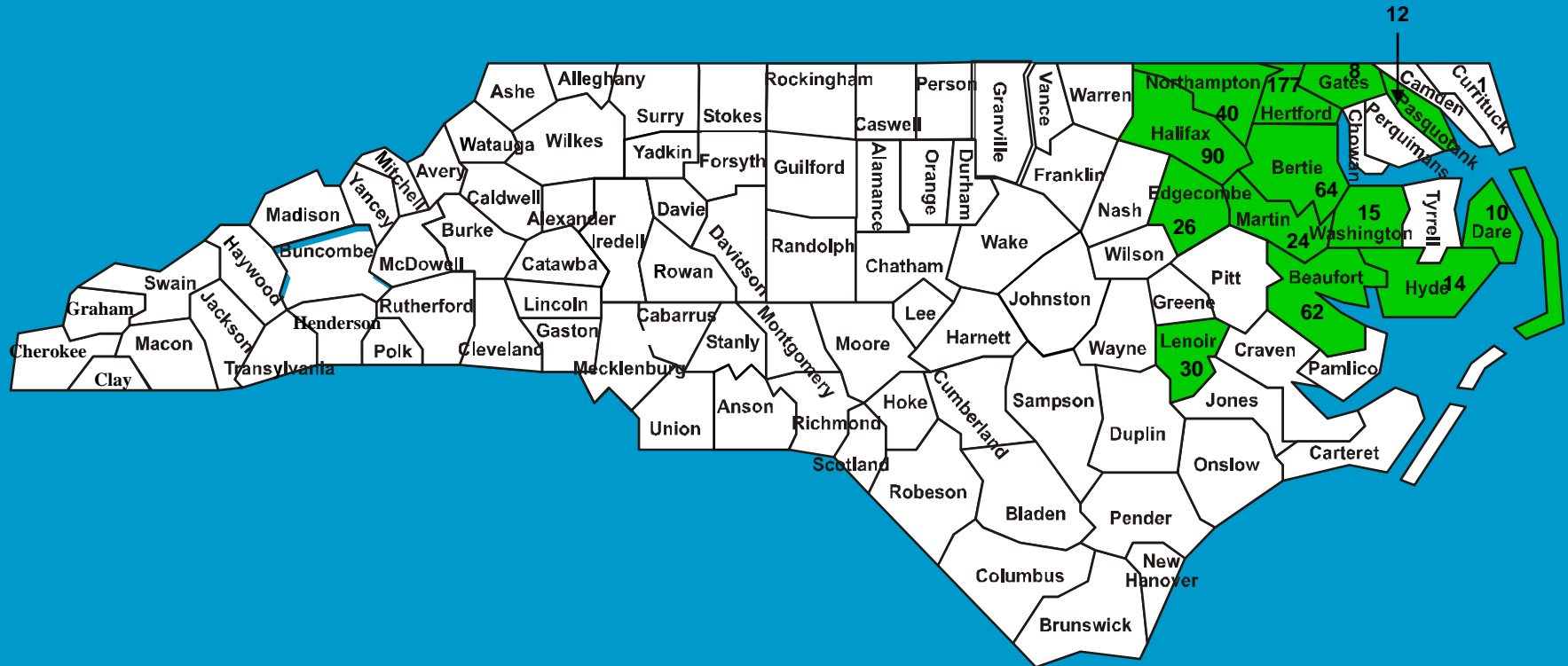

Health in Motion HIV Testing

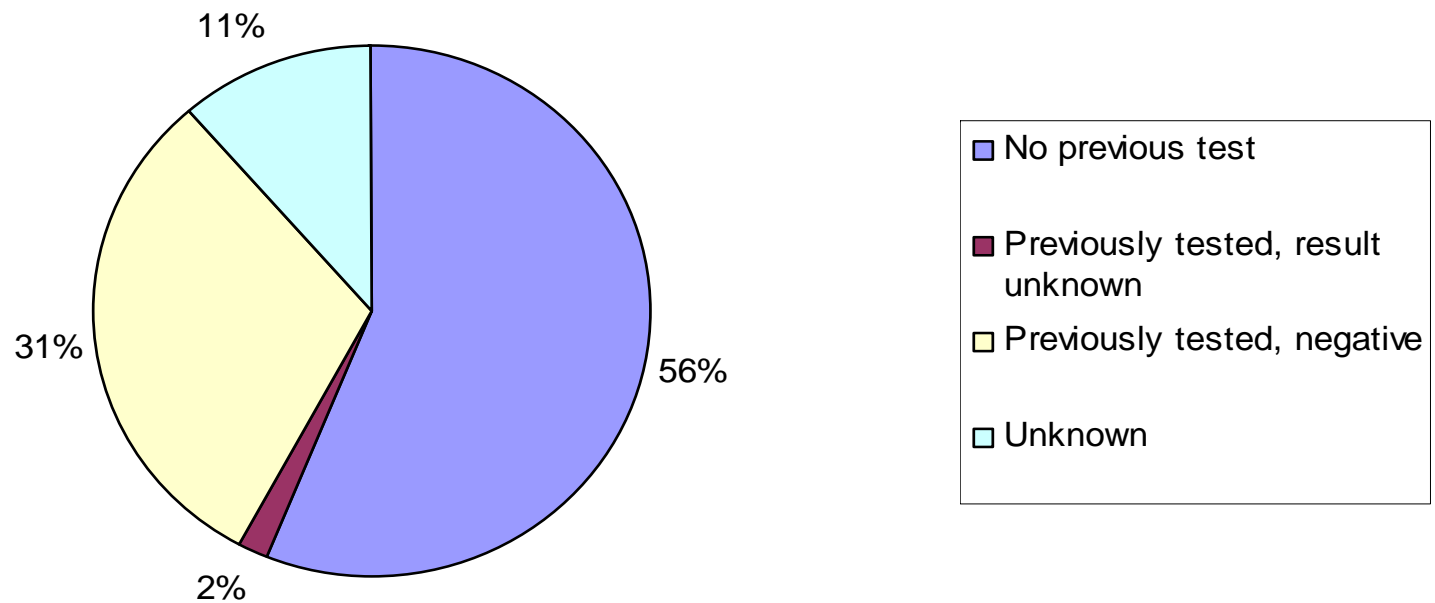
Number Tested in Counties where Activities Occurred

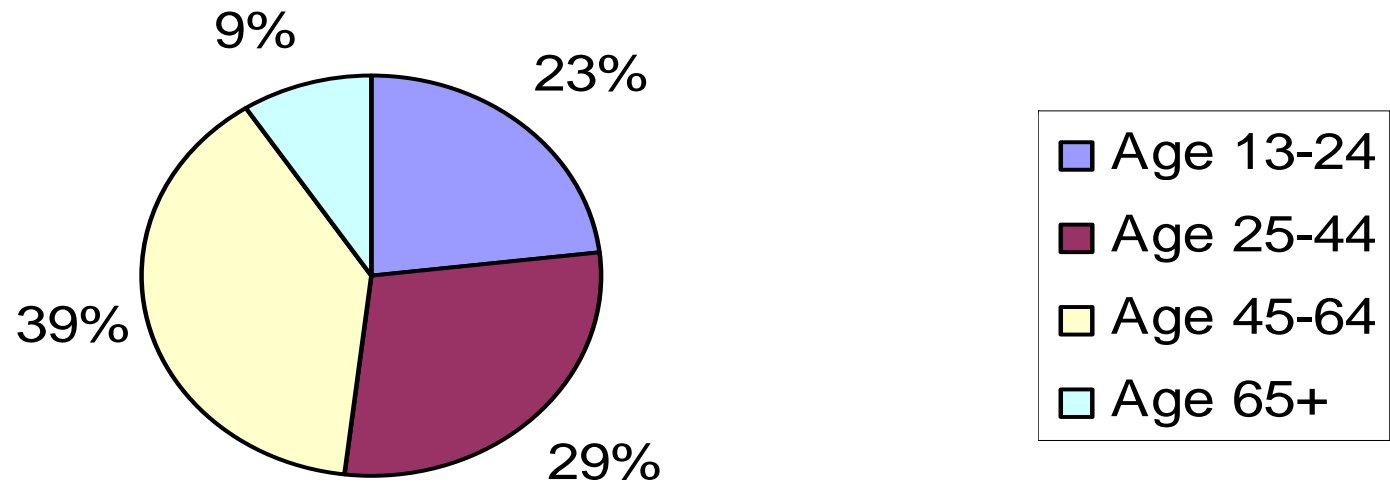
**Clients' HIV Test History

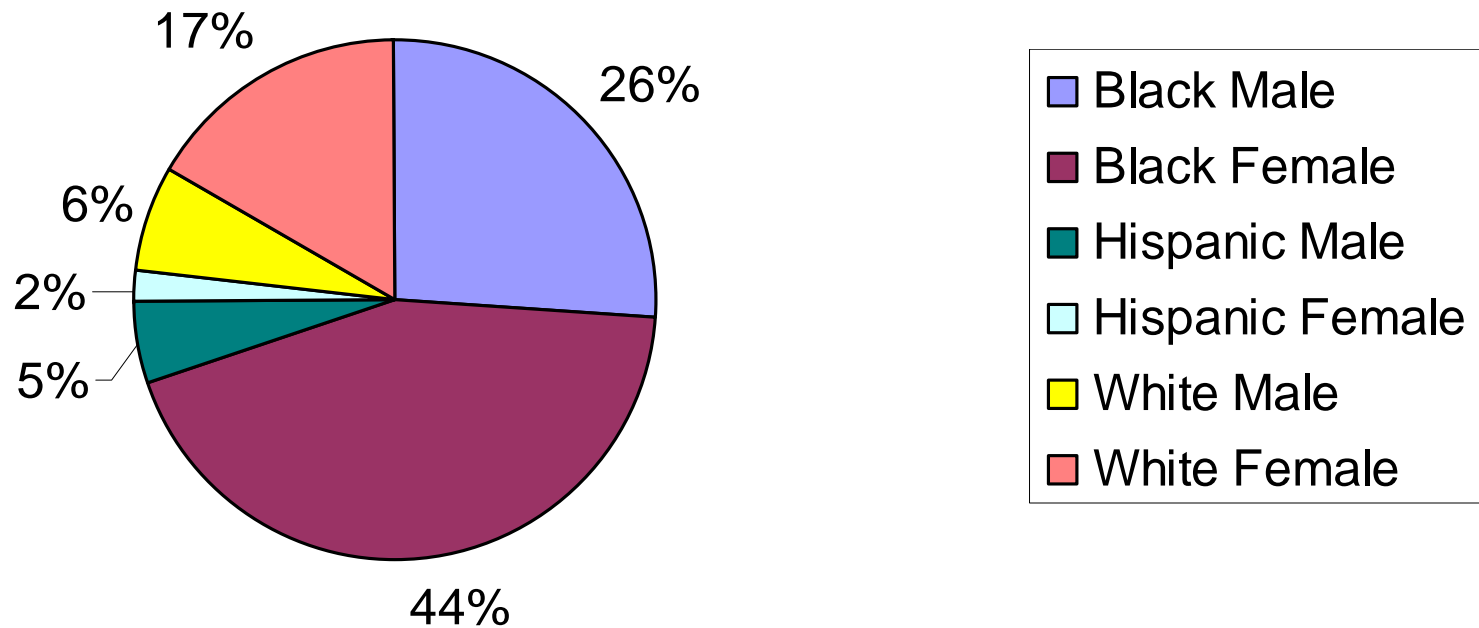
Clients Tested for HIV by Age Group January 07-December 07

HIV Testing Achievements

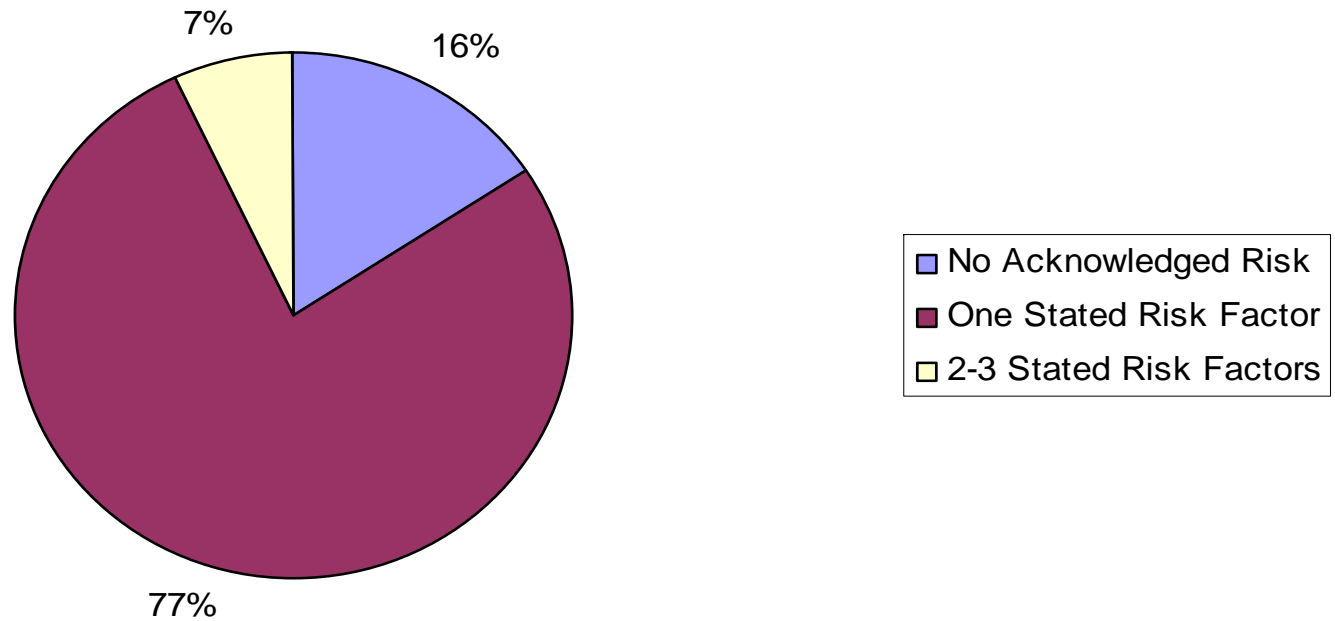
**Clients Tested for HIV by Race and Gender

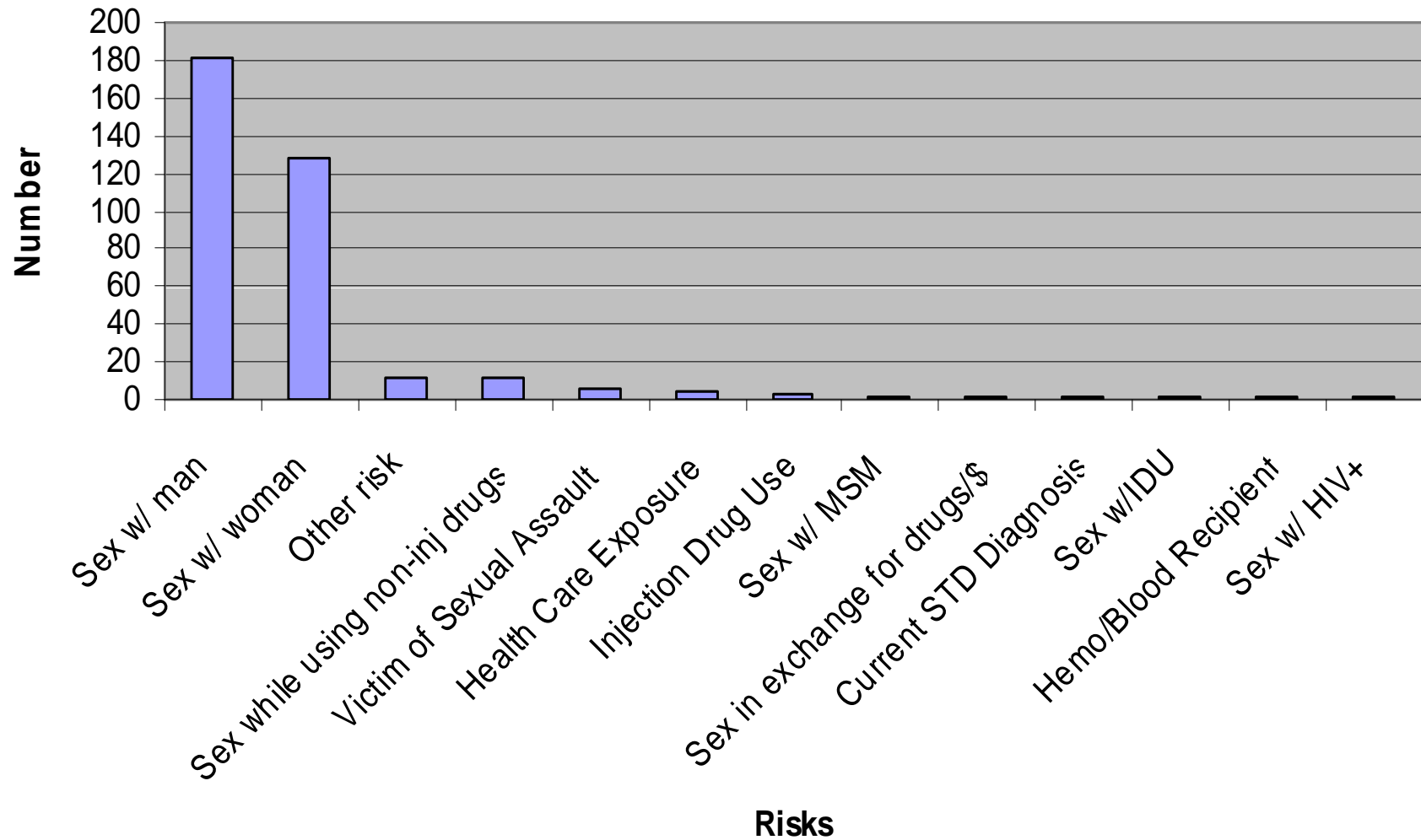
HIV Testing Achievements

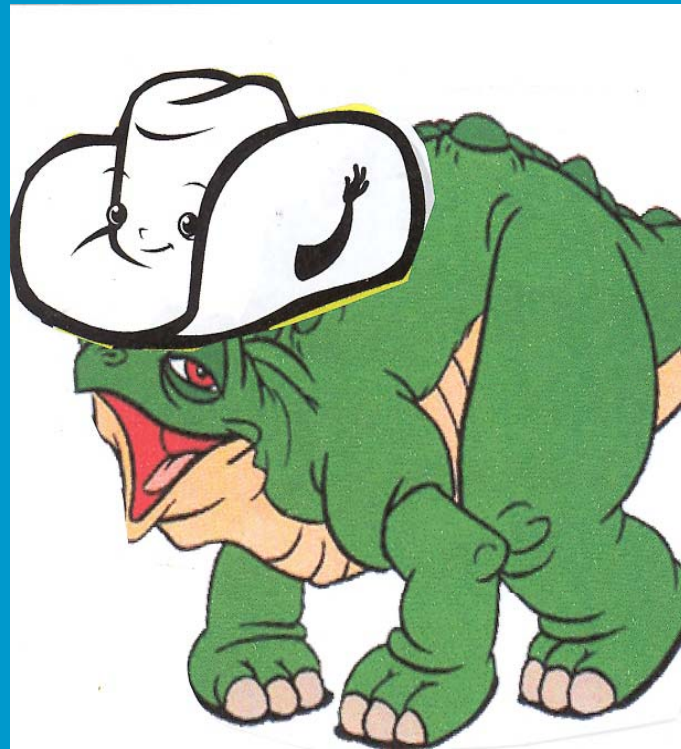

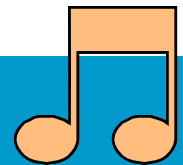
